This is a preliminary census of species listed as present in the lake itself or adjacent area including Ridgefield National Wildlife Refuge. Sources include bird lists from both Shillapoo state wildlife area and Ridgefield National Wildlife Refuge, NOAA ESA webpages (<http://www.nmfs.noaa.gov/pr/laws/esa>), and the state of Washington department of fish and wildlife Species of Concern website (<http://wdfw.wa.gov/wlm/diversty/soc/concern.htm>). The area might also be used by wildlife that is also listed as threatened or endangered by other states such as Oregon and Idaho. This list does not include possible listed insect and plant species.
